NOTICE IS GIVEN THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BALLINGER WILL MEET AT 5:30 P.M. ON MARCH 7, 2022, AT CITY HALL, 700 RAILROAD AVENUE IN THE CITY OF BALLINGER, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING THE FOLLOWING AGENDA ITEMS.

All agenda items are subject to action. The city council reserves the right to meet in a closed session on any agenda item should the need arise and if applicable pursuant to authorization by Title 5, Chapter 551, of the Texas Government Code.

- 1. Call meeting to order.**
- 2. Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance and pledge to Texas Flag.**
- 3. CITIZEN COMMENT:** Any citizen who desires to address the City Council on a matter not included on the agenda may do so at this time. Per the Texas Open Meetings Act, the City Council may not deliberate on items presented under this agenda item and can only provide factual information in response to an inquiry or recite existing policy or consider placing the item on a future agenda. All presentations are subject to a three (3) minute time limit.
- 4. REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND/OR CONSIDERATION**
 - a. Ordinance adopting TML Health Insurance modification:** finalize the insurance benefits to retirees both pre-and post-65 as defined by council.
 - b. Ordinance adopting TMRS Buyback:** Periodically the city has renewed its retirement buyback ordinance through TMRS which allows employees as of the date of approval of the ordinance to buy back credits previously cashed out. There is no cost to the city unless an employee chooses to buy back their credits.
 - c. Leasing of Police Department units:** Discuss and act upon leasing options for patrol units.

 - b. Park Board Easter Egg hunt** April 9th to be held at city park starts at 10 A.M.
